

Public Holidays Spring 2020

Changes in traffic

Public holidays during the Spring affect the regular road freight schedule – please find below changes in collection and distribution during Easter, Labour Day, Ascension Day and Pentecost.

Easter

For both exports and imports, the following applies:

- Departure takes place week 15, but with extended lead times in connection with the holidays.
- Departure takes place week 16, starting on Tuesday, 14 April, with extended lead times as a result.

Labour Day

Limited or pre-scheduled departures during week 18. No departures or deliveries on 1 May.

Ascension Day

Limited departures for export shipments Tuesday 19 May and Wednesday 20 May. Cancelled departures on Thursday, 21 May, but regular departures on Friday, 22 May. Import shipments are loaded throughout week 21, with the exception of Thursday 21 May.

Pentecost

Whit Monday, 1 June, is still a public holiday in major parts of Europe, which affects the regular schedule. Export shipments departing on Friday 29 May will be delivered one day later than usual*. For import shipments week 23, loading will take place on 2-5 June.
